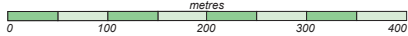

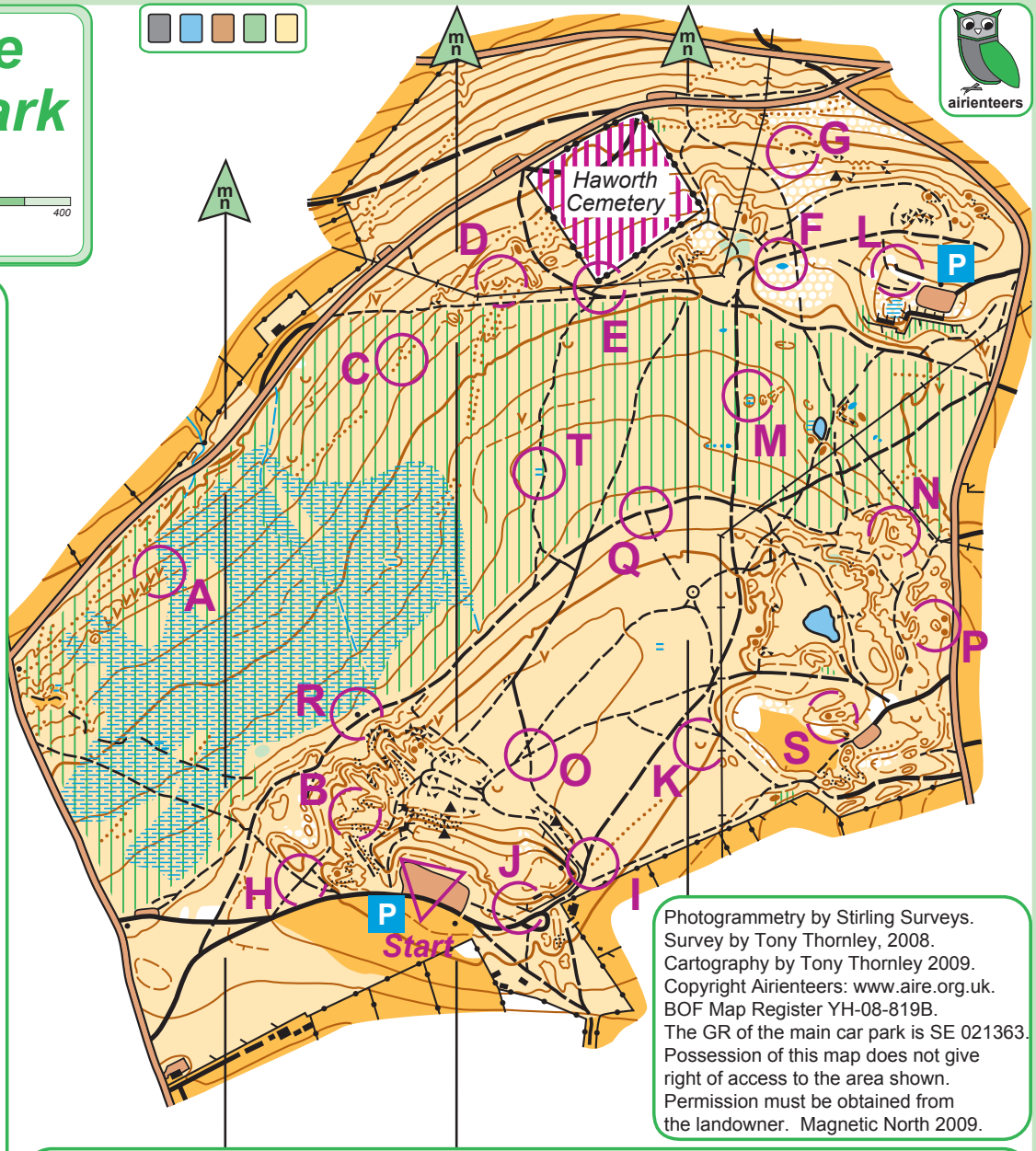

Permanent Orienteering Course

When you get to the centre of the circle on the map you will find a post. The post is marked with the letter shown and a number you can write down to prove you've been there. B**	Middle spur, top	L**	Crag 2m, W foot
C***	Gully junction	M*	Marsh, N side
D**	Depression, E edge	N***	Large depression
E*	Northern path bend	O*	Southern path junction
F*	Pond, N side	P***	Large depression
G***	Boulder 1m, NE side	Q*	Path junction, N side
H*	Path junction	R*	Boulder 1m, NE side
I*	Gully end	S**	Knoll, E side
J*	Fence end	T*	Marsh, S side
