# **Roundhay Park Evening Comeback Event**

## **Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> August**

### **(Subject to permissions)**

#### **COVID-19.**

By entering entrants are acknowledging that they must not attend if they or a member of their household has COVID-19 symptoms, or if they've been asked to isolate by NHS Test and Trace and that they will abide by the Participant Code of Conduct issued by British Orienteering at all times. Copy on event website page.

We have adhered to the British Orienteering guidelines. Social distancing, pre-entry only, allocated start times to maintain maximum 10 starts in 15 mins, (two starts for this event), hand sanitiser available, easy car parking, starts close to car park to prevent gathering at the starts.

Hand Sanitiser will be available at Starts and Download

#### **Directions / Parking**

Car park at the north end of Park Avenue and, if full, roadside on Park Avenue, LS8 2JL. There will be no car parking marshals. Please park in the car park or on the approach road - observing any Covid-19 restrictions that will be in place and showing consideration to local residents. The car park and roadside parking will be shared with members of the public.

#### **Start Times**

Start times from 6:00 pm to 7:30pm.

Courses close at 8:30pm. Because of shortening days if you think you are going to be out for some time please request an early start time.

#### **Entry Details**

#### **No entries on the day.**

SI card hire will be pre-orders only. Hire SI cards should be picked up at the payment desk, where the cards will be disinfected and bagged.

#### **Entries close midnight on Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> August.**

Fees Seniors £4.00. Juniors and Students £2.00

**Payment will be taken by either Contactless Card or correct change cash only.** Payment desk will be situated between north end of car park and starts.

#### **Terrain Description**

Mixed Open and formal Parkland with extensive woodland areas.

#### **Course Information**

Waterproof paper 1:10000 map. 5m contours, drawn by Chris Burden

Orange: Moderately Easy 2.6k 60m - For less experienced orienteers.

Short Green: Hard 3.2k 75m

Green: Hard 4.1k 110m

All course lengths subject to final controlling.

On the course socially distance from other competitors and the public.

At control points please be patient if waiting to dib an SI box.

## Starts

You will be allocated a start time on the pre entry system. Please do your best to adhere to it. However, if you are late there are slots to fit you in.

There will be 2 starts both approx.100m from and signed from the north side of the Lakeside Café car park.

Start 1 – Green Start 2 - Short Green, Orange.

You should aim to arrive at the start for your start time with the minimum of standing around.

The start clocks will display the -1 call up time. If you arrive very early please move away from the start area and come back. Please keep social distance at all times.

At call up you should undertake prestart procedures yourselves.

SIAC Battery Test, Clear, Check, SIAC Test will be on stakes. You need to dib these in this order for SIAC cards. For standard and hire dibbers it is Clear then Check.

**There are no loose description sheets.**

On start time pick map from course box taking care to ensure you only pick up one.

Remember to dib start box.

## Electronic Punching

This will be a mixed punching event: normal SI cards or SIACs can be used. Controls will be enabled for Contactless punching with SIACs.

The punching Start and Finish will not be in Contactless mode and need to be dibbed by all competitors.

***It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that their dibber has registered at the control.***

**Finish:** When you finish please catch your breath and then go straight to download which will be visible just off the path in the direction of the car park.

**Download:** Please ensure you download when you finish your course. Download will be positioned at a Covid safe position both for competitors and the download volunteer. **There will be no 'splits' printout.** Hand sanitiser will be available at download. If you do have to queue please maintain social distancing. If you have a query please inform the download volunteer, at a social distance.

A box will be provided for return hire dibbers to be dropped into.

When download complete make your way straight to your car.

**Toilets:** No toilets will be provided at the Event. Please ensure you go before arrival.
