



Club Development Officer

We are looking to appoint a part-time, paid Club Development Officer with aim of improving active membership of the club with a focus on diversity and hard to reach areas. They will do this by networking through social media, publicising our local events to local communities and groups etc, developing and running activities that engage those new to orienteering and supporting new and prospective members.

The CDO will have some experience of generating publicity through social media etc, working with communities, have or will obtain a current DBS check and be a reasonable orienteer. They will need to be a good coordinator, communicator, and motivator, and can demonstrate that by their previous experience. Our previous CDO is willing to mentor a newcomer into the role.

The CDO will be expected to work about 300 hours per year for the club (which works out approximately 6 hours per week but the timing is flexible). Remuneration will be an hourly rate of £11.44 (or relevant living wage) per hour, travel at 25p per mile and expenses.
