The following travel passes are available from Leeds Train Station

Family DayRover For groups of up to five people (up to two adults and up to three children or other concessionary passengers* or one adult and up to four concessionary passengers*) on both buses and trains. £8.00

Train & Bus DayRover - for one adult on both buses and trains. £5.50

Bus DayRover - for one adult on buses only. £4.50

Adult Train DayRover - for one adult on trains only. £5.00

Concessionary Train DayRover- for one child or other concessionary passenger* on trains only. £2.50

Cheap day return Leeds-Skipton: Adult - £7.00, Child - £3.50

Bus day rover tickets can be purchased on board
