All three events are very accessible by public transport, with assembly areas being no more than 15 minutes walk from the nearest rail station (buses go even closer). Airienteers would like to encourage competitors to travel by public transport, and there will be a £2/£1 discount/refund per person at each event available to all those travelling by train/bus and showing a valid ticket or travelpass. SportIdent electronic timing will be used for all the events

The events take place on open courses, with traffic. All courses (except novice) cross busy roads. For this reason, the races are not suitable for under 14s[†]. Competitors enter the events at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety. The event is registered and insured with British Orienteering.
